## **Information:**

Chapman Hill is located off of Florida Road in Durango. There is skier drop off at the base of the hill. There is overflow parking across the street at the Church, Folsom Park and on top of Chapman Hill at the college. There are also town shuttles that stop at Chapman Hill, please get a bus route map at the transit center in town.

The event check-in will be at the Ice Arena. Competitor lift tickets are \$8 each day or \$20 for three days. Parent tickets are \$10 each day. Chapman Hill is serviced by a rope tow. Round trip loops on the rope tow are 3 minutes including your run. It is strongly advised to use old gloves or purchase cheap work gloves to ride the rope tow!
