Information:

Chapman Hill is located off of Florida Road in Durango. There is skier drop off at the base of the hill. There is overflow parking across the street at the Church, Folsom Park and on top of Chapman Hill at the college. There are also town shuttles that stop at Chapman Hill, please get a bus route map at the transit center in town.

The event check in will be at the Ice Arena. Competitor lift tickets are \$8 each day or \$20 for three days. Parent tickets are \$10 each day. Chapman Hill is serviced by a rope tow. Round trip loops on the rope tow are 3 minutes including your run. It is strongly advised to use old gloves or purchase cheap work gloves to ride the rope tow! For those who may not be familiar with riding the rope tow or may have difficulty getting to the top, Mild to Wild rafting is offering a shuttle to the top of the hill for \$20 each day. Round trip loops on the shuttle are 20 minutes.

There is plenty of reasonable lodging in Durango. You will be able to find deals over the internet. There is also a great Recreation center in town that features a pool, hot tub, diving boards and exercise bicycles.
