TIME: 7:45am to 9:00am at SSCV (Ski & Snowboard Club Vail)

Address: SSCV, 598 Vail Valley Drive, Vail, Colorado, 81657

Direction: Golden Peak Area of Vail, at Chair6 / Riva Bahn. The SSCV clubhouse is two buildings past Golden Peak Lodge, same side of rd, right side, aka. Slope side.

Parking: **THERE IS NO PARKING AT SSCV, ONLY DROP OFF!**

Your parking options are: (\$25)Village Parking Structure or (\$35)Manor Vail – it's directly across from SSCV. The golf course is no longer available. The only free parking is far away ☺

Lift Tickets

Athlete tickets: \$45.00(?) and can be purchased at SSCV. Full Epic season passes & the Local Epic are also valid on these dates.

Coach tickets: **USASA** or **USSA** certified coaches will receive tickets complementary and can obtain those at SSCV. To obtain a lift ticket you are REQUIRED TO SHOW PROOF of your current coaching license or your current coach license NUMBER for lookup.

Parent Tickets: \$55.00(?). A voucher will be given to parents to take over to Golden Peak Lodge ticket window (two building down from SSCV, in front of chair 6). Full Epic & Local Epic season pass are also valid.

***No training day tickets for parents**

***No Foot Passenger access to the venues via lifts. Must hike!**

***Uphill transport can be arranged if done in advance for a special needs person.**

USSA - Here's what you need to know:

USSA Bring your bib from the last two seasons. If you have never been issued a Rocky bib, one will be assigned to you at check-in. This will be your bib for the whole season. There is an additional \$30 fee to replace a lost bib during the season after the issuance of the competitor's initial bib. Loaner bibs are available for a weekend, for a deposit of \$30, **CASH ONLY**, and a fee of \$10. You must wear that bib!

Access to Venue: Slopestyle course or Halfpipe venue will be via Chair 6 / Riva Bahn at Golden Peak Area – you can easily ski from SSCV Clubhouse to this chair lift and back to clubhouse.

Day Storage: You can leave your belongings inside SSCV, but fair warning, it's crowded!

THERE WILL NOT BE A COMPETITOR LANE at the chairlift. All competitors must enter the lift maze the same as the public. Please obey signs and slow areas. Please be courteous to all Vail Resorts employees.

Awards will be in the backyard of SSCV, which is slope side.

- 10:15am – 3:00pm Competition,
*1st competition is best of two runs, second competition may only be one run depending on time. Same start list for all runs.
- 3:30pm Awards – out back of SSCV
