**TIME:** 7:30am to 9:00am at **Gold Peak Grill (Gold Peak Lodge, Bottom floor)**

**Check-in:** The table will be located @ Gold Peak Grill, inside the front doors, 1<sup>st</sup> floor.

**Address:** 458 Vail Valley Drive, Vail, Colorado, 81657

**Direction:** Directions- Coming From Denver, exit at Vail Village exit #176, proceed around the roundabout back under I-70, go around the second roundabout and head east on the north frontage road. Go past the Vail Parking Structure and go right on Vail Valley Drive. The Gold Peak Lodge is located on your right.

**Parking:** **THERE IS NO PARKING AT SSCV, ONLY DROP OFF!**

Your parking options are: (\$25)Village Parking Structure or (\$35)Manor Vail –it's directly across from SSCV. The golf course is no longer available. The only free parking is far away ☺

## Lift Tickets

**Athlete tickets:** \$45 and can be purchased at Gold Peak Lodge (cash/check/credit cards accepted). Full Epic season passes & the Local Epic are also valid on these dates.

**Coach tickets:** **USASA** or **USSA** certified coaches will receive tickets complementary and can obtain those at SSCV. To obtain a lift ticket you are REQUIRED TO SHOW PROOF of your current coaching license or your current coach license NUMBER for lookup.

**Parent Tickets:** \$70.00 at registration. Full Epic & Local Epic season pass are also valid.

\*No training day tickets for parents

\*No Foot Passenger access to the venues via lifts. Must hike!

\*Uphill transport can be arranged if done in advance for a special needs person.

## USSA - Here's what you need to know:

**USSA Bibs** will be assigned at the **Check-in** table, 7:45am to 9:00am at SSCV. You must wear that bib! Permanent bibs are free for USSA members with Freestyle Competitor licenses. There will be a \$20 refundable bib deposit for USSA members with Freeskiing Competitor or Freestyle Youth licenses. **CASH ONLY** for Bib deposits.

**THERE WILL NOT BE A COMPETITOR LANE** at the chairlift. All competitors must enter the lift maze the same as the public. Please obey signs and slow areas. Please be courteous to all Vail Resorts employees.

Awards will be in the backyard of SSCV, which is slope side.

- 10:00am Rider & Coach Meeting at top of venue
- 10:15am Competition Starts (see start list for your run position)
- 10:15am – 3:00pm Competition,

\*2 competitions for each competitor, first competition will have 2 runs (best of 2), second competition will have 1 run (2 runs if time permits) Same start list for all runs

- 3:30pm Awards – out back of SSCV
